MIXING PROCEDURES:

- 1 Dispersions [3caps to 24oz.]
- 2 Acid-Free Stain [50% stain to 50% water]
- 3 Acrylic Concrete Stains [50% stain to 50% water]

Step by step procedure: [Flood-spot flood-Mist specle--%---still wet .etc.]

1	Apply all Granicrete countertop blend coats per installation instructions.
	Texture for contrasting colors.
2	Wet surface with water. Flood 100% of surface with Groutline Grey for background color and let dry.
3	Spot flood surface about 20% with Charcoal in random order to highlight. Let settle and add color to
	desired look. While damp go to step 4.
4	Mist Stonehenge over 20% randomely, let dry.
5	Use Copper to create veins. Small bottle with needle nose opening will help.
6	Option: Use Silver or Gold glitter if desired.
7	Repeat as needed for the finish to customers preference.
